PRISON MINISTRY – Visiting inmates in several prisons across the state, serving as mentor / teacher / visitor at Adobe Mountain School and corresponding with inmates as pen pals.

SECURITY

HALL MONITORS – Couples to monitor and assist teachers and children in the hallways and restrooms during services.

CAMPUS SECURITY – Patrolling the campus parking lot and directing traffic during services and special events.

SERVICE

30 MINUTE CLEAN TEAM – Help serve the body through cleaning after each service.

COMMUNION PREPARATION – Prepare bread and juice trays for communion on Sunday evening and for special services.

HOSPITALITY – Assisting with food preparation and service for luncheons, memorial services and special ministry events.

MANNA MINISTRY – Coupon clipping and grocery shopping to stock our food pantry.
